Advanced international training courses in health risk assessment

RA-COURSES funding for PhD students and post docs

RA-COURSES will offer funding for PhD students and post docs to participate in the courses organised by RA-COURSES.

Eligibility criteria

You are eligible for funding if you fulfil the criteria in either group 1 or 2.

Group 1:

Participant attending the course for training purposes, who is, at the time of his/her attendance, in the first 4 years of his/her research activity, including the period of research training, since gaining a university degree giving access to doctoral studies in the country, in which the degree was obtained and who has not yet obtained a doctoral degree.

Group 2:

Participant attending the course for training purposes, who, have at the time of his/her attendance, at least 4 years and less than 10 years of research experience, since gaining a university degree giving him/her access to doctoral studies in the country in which the degree was obtained, or is already in possession of a doctoral degree, independently of the time taken to acquire it.

In addition account will be taken to that nationals of the same Member State or Associated State do not represent more than 30% of the total number of participants.

Number of funded participants

Up to 20 eligible participants from group 1 and 5 eligible participants from group 2 will be funded for each course.

Funding

The funding will cover the course fee, and give a contribution towards the travel and accommodation costs on a real cost basis within a maximum amount, which depends on European Commission rates on costs of living in the country and travel distance. Participants receiving funding will be reimbursed after the course.

Application

You apply for the funding by completing the application form for the course.
